

**Minutes**  
**Public Safety Committee**  
**August 5, 2014**  
**6:00 PM**  
**3rd committee meeting**

**Members present were Chairman Bob Cook, Committee members Taft Matney and Scott Crosby. Chief Bryan Turner and City Administrator Trey Eubanks were also present. Judge Martin and Chief Sapp were outside helping with National Night Out.**

1. Call to order.- Chairman Cook

3. Reading and approval of minutes- Councilman Crosby made a motion to approve the minutes with Councilman Matney seconding. The vote was unanimous (3-0).
4. Reports or communications from city officers
  - a. Budget reports
  - b. Chief Turner- Chief Turner reported that the Youth Academies were completed and went well this year. This was our seventh year. There have been some break-ins this summer, but not as many this year as in years past. CALEA Accreditation continues. Sgt. McCord is attending some advanced training for improvement in our dispatch area.
  - c. Angela Martin- Trey said jury trials begin Monday. Both Administrative Judges have completed their training.
  - d. Chief Sapp- The fire department budget is in good shape. Chief Sapp is working on getting us transferred over to VOA with the City's computer network. Training is taking place this week.

6. New business.
  - a. Wrecker fees- These haven't been looked at since 2005. Chief looked at some earlier correspondence and talked to different agencies regarding this subject. Chief Turner developed a guideline for council to look at for rates within the City with stranded motorists, wrecks, violations or arrests, as well as storage and standby fees. Chief said he would like to review this every couple of years.

This item was moved to council. Chairman Crosby included in the motion to review this every two years as well.

Mayor Raines asked how much the proposed increase would be. Chief Turner will get this information to Council. Mayor asked if we had any input on the proposed changes. Chief Turner said we haven't sent anything to the wrecker companies. This is being looked at because of a letter we received from Jerry Green to go through the fees.
