 - a. Economic Development- John Gardner reported that work continues on annexation and he hopes to bring some petitions forward in the next month or two. There has been discussion with a local company to try to find them a larger space. Interest from three developers has been received on new multi-family residential development. Landscaping is in at the Bridges Road/Corn Road project. We are waiting on permission from a property owner to put an entranceway way sign in.
 - b. Office of Cultural Affairs- George is developing the RFQs for the public art program and should be released next month. Last year, 28491 people came to the cultural center. The website is updated.

Trey stated that following discussion, the Mayor and he had a productive meeting regarding the downtown master plan and that something would come to council during the meeting on January 20th.
