

ORDINANCE # _____

An ordinance to amend Article 6 of the Official Zoning Ordinance and Map of the City of Mauldin, the purpose of which is to allow on-street parking on City owned streets when specifically approved in the acceptance of a newly dedicated City street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Mauldin, South Carolina, in council assembled and by authority thereof that the Mauldin Zoning Ordinance be amended as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. That section 6:9.4 of the Mauldin Zoning Ordinance be amended to add the following language after the last sentence:

On-street parking shall be permissible in properly improved parking spaces which conform to the dimensional requirements of section 6:9.5 that are located outside of the lanes of travel but within the road right-of-way. On-street parking must comply with requirements of section 6:9.5 before a road can be accepted into the City street system by the Mayor and City Council.

Section 2. Effective Date. That said amendment shall become effective upon second and final reading.
