a. Alcohol ordinance

This is a recommendation to limit the sale of alcoholic beverages during certain hours in the City. No alcohol will be sold for on-premises consumption after 2:00 a.m. The City of Travelers Rest, Simpsonville, Fountain Inn, Greer, and Clemson have similar ordinances and this one is modeled after the City of Greenville's.

Councilman Black asked about penalties. Trey Eubanks said there is a fine up to \$500 or up to 30 days in jail. We have a penalty section in our code of ordinances and we can insert the penalty section into the ordinance.

Councilman Black asked how the businesses would be notified. Chief Turner said that there are 6 businesses that are affected and we will notify each business individually.
